Member and Liaison Update

Judge Maddock conveyed that he contacted the Executive and Planning Committee Chair, as rule 10.61 requires a member who is also a member of the Court Facilities Advisory Committee, and states that at least one member of the committee should be from a court that uses a marshal for court security services.

Trial Court Security Survey Update

Judge Maddock reported that the report was ready for electronic distribution, and that staff would distribute surveys by e-mail to each Court Executive Officer with a cc to the Presiding Judge, allowing 30 days for responses. Results will be shared with committee members and eventually, chairs of the facilities advisory committees, Court Executive Advisory Committee, and Trial Court Presiding Judges Advisory Committee.
