Questions-Oral

- 1. Binding Questions: Only questions submitted in writing are binding. Please submit questions per the published form and process in the RFQ. Question and answer form should be used. Please mail to specified mailbox.
- 2. Pre-registration: No requirement for pre-registration to submit.
- 3. Budgets: Published construction budgets are in 2006 dollars, escalated to the start and mid-point of construction. Budgets are for all hard costs of construction, including site preparation, FF&E, telecommunications, and exclude soft costs including A&E fees.
- 4. Parking: Underlying assumptions will apply; some parking studies may be required in connection with site planning, CEQA and related site acquisition phase work.
- 5. Form 330: Use Form 330 as specified for prime consultants and subconsultants.
- 6. Sustainability: Projects will be sustainably designed as indicated.
- 7. Specific questions: Specific questions per project should be submitted accordingly, e.g. San Bernardino-Project planning will consider master planning options for San Bernardino, including future government center development

San Joaquin-Parking impacts will be considered in site study/studies

Madera-Downtown government center is already developed, separate from proposed project

Tulare-Numerous sites will be considered Long Beach-Not included in this solicitation

- 8. Built projects: Examples of completed work should include built projects.
- 9. Geotech and Survey: Included in architects' scope
- 10. Contract terms: Have been updated to reflect CM@Risk language

- 11. Insurance provisions: Have been updated; will be specific to each project
- 12. RFQ Section 4.3.3: Constructed institutional project examples should be included in SOQ
- 13. Single or Multiple submissions: Include one or more as best reflect individual teams
